

FAMILY OF QWAQWA POLICEMAN COMFORTED BY GAUTENG PREMIER



The Executive Mayor of Thabo Mofutsanyana District Municipality, Dr B.E. Mzangwa, on Monday 22 July 2013 accompanied the Premier of Gauteng Province Honourable Nomvula Mokonyane, the Free State MEC for Police, Roads and Transport Butana Khompela and Gauteng MEC for Social Development Nandi Mayathula-Khoza to deliver messages of condolences to the family of a policeman, Sgt Tebogo Motsie.

Motsie, whose home is in Qwaqwa, died in a car accident together with Gauteng MEC for economic development Nkosiphendule Kolisile and his colleague Constable Tshepo Jobo over the weekend on the N6 in the Free State on their way to a funeral in the Eastern Cape.

Flanked by MEC Khompela, MEC Mayathula-Khoza and Executive Mayor Dr Mzangwa, the visibly distraught Gauteng Premier expressed sadness to the loss of young promising politician and police officials.

“Gauteng province is poorer without MEC Kolisile. The country is poorer without MEC Kolisile. The police service is poorer without the two policemen. All these were young men, who still had much to offer,” said Mokonyane.

She said her provincial government with the support of the Free State Provincial Government and Thabo Mofutsanyana District Municipality will continue to provide the family of Motsie with all the necessary support and assistance towards his funeral services.

Motsie will be buried on Sunday in Qwaqwa.
